- As 2 units of English must be included for an ATAR, students choosing English Studies are NOT eligible for an ATAR. Students cannot transfer from English Studies to Standard or Advanced English at the end of the Preliminary Year as the latter have mandatory Preliminary courses. Likewise, students cannot transfer from Mathematics General 1 to Mathematics General 2 or Mathematics at the end of the Preliminary Course.
- Students are asked to choose RE, English, and seven (7) other courses in order of preference.
- English Extension may not be completed without English Advanced. Mathematics Extension may not be completed without Mathematics.
- In the Preliminary Course, Senior Science cannot be studied in combination with Biology, Chemistry or Physics.
