This day promises to be a chance for your child to deepen their faith and share with their peers the joy that connecting with God can bring to their lives.

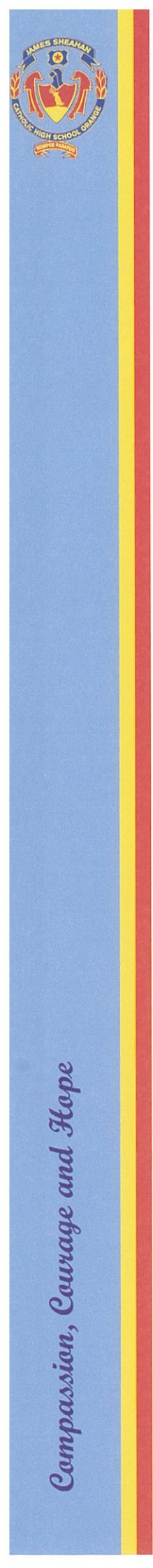
Where to meet - Students will be required to meet in the school bus bay at 8.45am and travel to and from the venue by bus. The student will return to school by 3.00pm.
