

Revised Mobile Phone Policy - 2018

Students in Years 7 to 10 are not to use mobile phones during school hours from 8.30am until 3.05pm. During this time mobile phones should be turned off and not seen. Any student found using a mobile phone during school hours will be asked to put it away. Avoidance of this will be classified as defiance. Repeat offenders may have their phones confiscated and parents may be contacted and asked to collect the phone from the Administration Centre. A detention may be issued.

Students in Years 11 and 12 are permitted to use mobile phones at recess and lunchtime. However, if they use a phone during class time, the phone may be confiscated and a parent may be expected to collect the phone from the school office. A detention may also be issued.

Emergency calls can be made from the School Office. Parents can leave urgent messages with the office staff.

The use of mobile phones on retreats, excursions, sports events and other school occasions may vary from the above policy.
